The time penalty will be as follows:

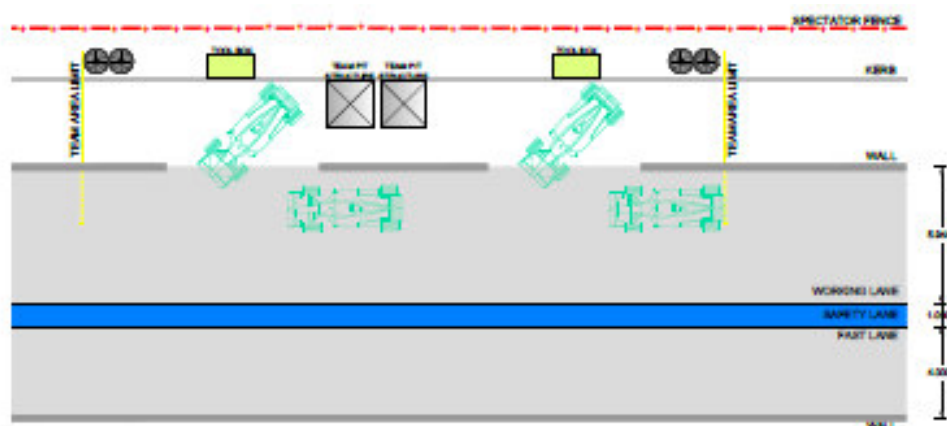
Drive Through	39 Seconds

4 – Change of Car, Article 37.6

For safety reasons there will be a reference time for the mandatory change of cars of 57 seconds and a minimum pit speed of 48 km/h.

5 – Change of Car, Article 37.6

The mandatory change of car will take place in front of the wall at the pit. The first car will be parked in front of the wall and will be pushed behind the wall after the pit stop. The first car will remain behind the wall under Parc Fermé conditions until the end of the Race Parc Fermé.



6 - Starting Procedure, Article 36)

Both cars have to be brought to the pits. The **first car** has to be at his pit with the driver **latest at 15.23 h** and the **second car latest at 16.03 h** and parked within the team space behind the wall, ready to go.

8 Parc fermé: The Parc fermé for the first 3 cars will be in front of the FIA Scrutineering Garage, and other cars if requested by Technical Delegate.

FORMULE E tyre working range recommendations

This document defines the tyre working range recommendations applicable to the tyres :

- Pilot Sport EV2 : F146941B/F146942B
- Typhoon : F146991E/F146992E
- Showcar : E146941A/E146942A

Definition :

Starting tyre pressure : Pressure measured at all time during the event, when the set of tyres is fitted to the car ready to run.

Running pressure : Pressure measured at all time during the event, after running.

Note: The allowed minimum **starting** pressure **do not guarantee** to reach the allowed **running** pressure.
